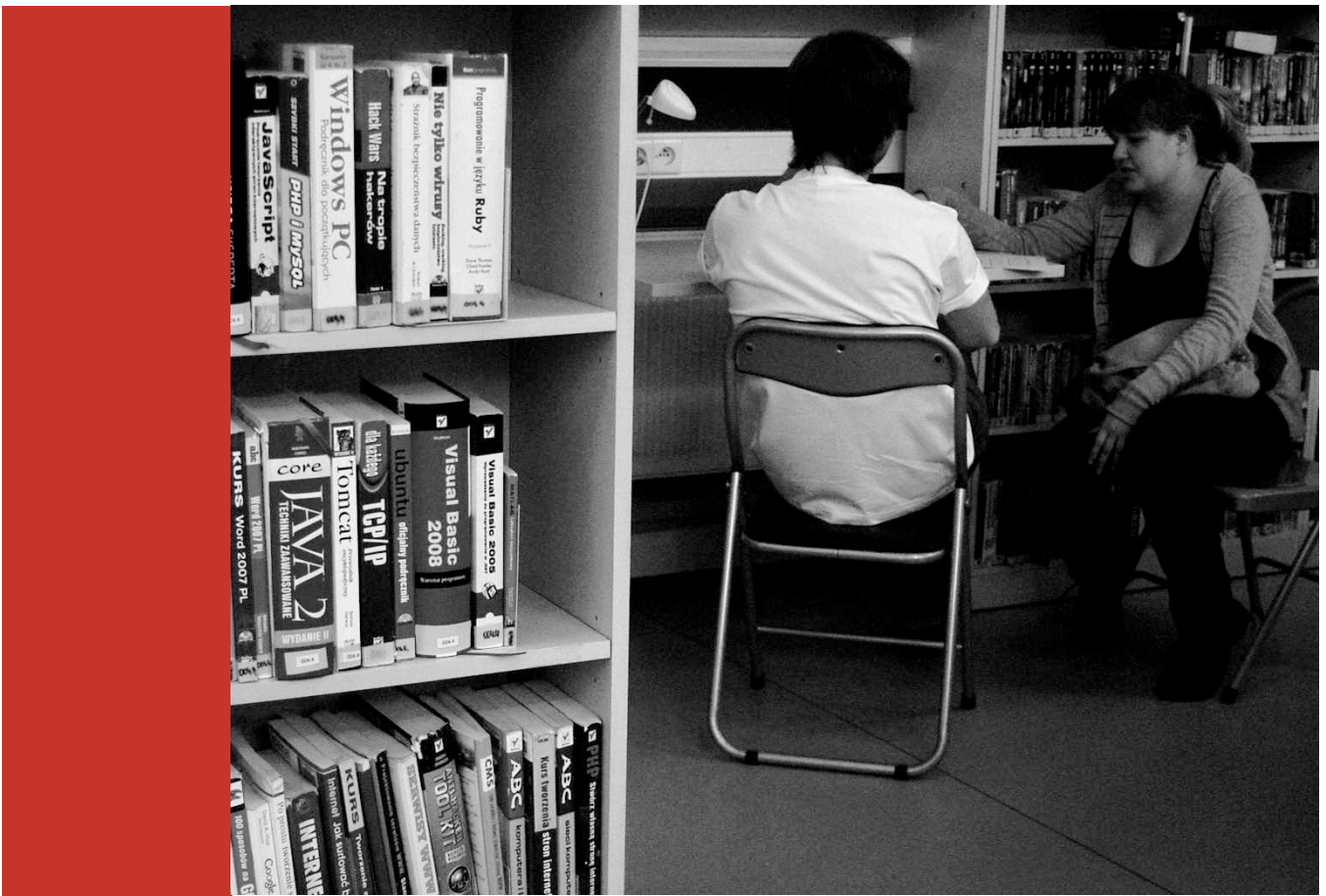

for Human Library Organisers 16th - 22nd of October, Darmstadt, Germany

Dear Partners, once again we are happy to announce that the Training Course for Human Library Organisers got the support of the Youth in Action Programme and will take place this fall.

We [Marc and Dora] are really excited about it: 24 people from 12 different countries will come to share, learn and develop further the method of Human Library! What more to wish for?

Why?

We have practiced the Human Library method for couple of years and we believe it works.

We want to spend this week with you in order to: reflect on human rights violations in Europe and in general, to analyse the potential of non-formal education methods in fighting human rights violations and to train you on the Human Library method as means of human rights education.

We will meet in **Jugendhof Bessunger Forst** a nice place close to a forrest, where fruitful discussions on our experiences on Human Right Education are assured.

Participants

Each partner organisation should select **2 participants** who are interested in the Human Library method and who are determinate to organise such event once completed the Training. You may want to involve your experienced youth workers and volunteers and send along those who are new in your organisation, so they could learn new method and get inspiration.

Please send us the name of the participants from your organisation by the **15th of September** 2011 latest.

Travel arrangements

The arrival day is the **16th of October** and the accommodation starts at 16.00; the departure day is the **22nd of October** after breakfast. Please plan the travel of your group accordingly. Each group will get a travel reimbursement of 70% of their travel costs. Please see below up to what amount you can buy your ticket. Please do not exceed this budget and please note that it is possible to buy your ticket only **after** the **1st of September**.

Costs of the training course

The accommodation, food, 70% of the travel costs and training tools are covered by the grant from Youth in Action Programme.

The participation fee is 30 euro.



Task of the participants

Each team of 2 participants from one organisation before the Training should prepare a presentation of the human rights violation situation in their countries. This can have various form [digital presentation, poster etc.] This will be shared with other participants as a step of the analysis of local needs that will be necessary for further implementation of Human Library projects in participants' contexts.

The hosting and partner organisations

Netzwerk ROPE e.V. is an independent non-profit organisation that – on behalf of the Science City of Darmstadt, Germany – runs its own youth centre. We have been active in project work on the local and on the international level for more than ten years, starting from training courses for multipliers in the framework of the EU's Youth (in Action) Programme and international youth exchanges to long-term projects supported by the European Social Fund. In our youth- and project-work we are focusing on strengths and resources of young people, especially of those people who are – for many different reasons - in danger of being excluded from society.

We try to establish the method(ology) of the Human Library or "Lebende Bibliothek" as a tool of Human Rights Education. With the help of European partners from Italy (GIOSEF), Poland (INCONTRO), and the Czech Republic (OPIM) we have been preparing our concept and approach from 2006 onwards and carried out our first two Human Libraries in 2010 in Darmstadt, Germany.

INCONTRO is a team of free-lance trainers active in the field of non-formal education, communication and development. We run diverse educational activities, mostly trainings for non profit and business organisation. In co-operation with a public library and an NGO, INCONTRO has co-ordinated 4 editions of Human Library in Wroclaw [Poland] and several trainings for future Human Library Organisers.
